

# Let's do phonics!

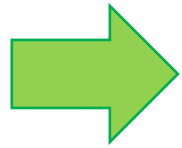


Hello friends!

e, e, e, e, e

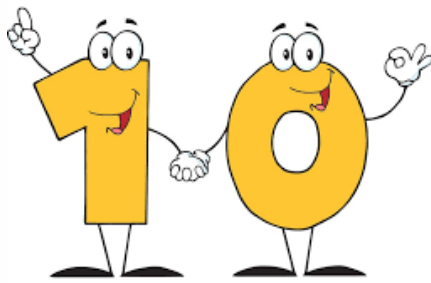
Wonderful job, friends!

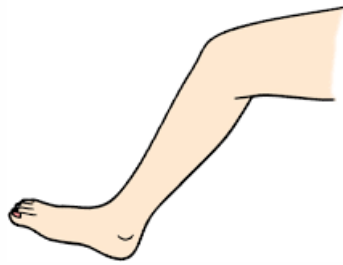
