

Let's do phonics!

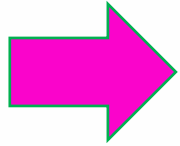


Hello friends!

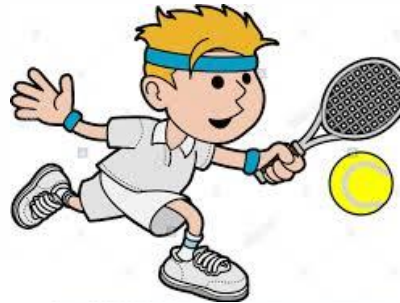
