

# Let's do phonics!

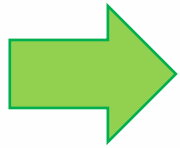


Hello friends!

Here we go!



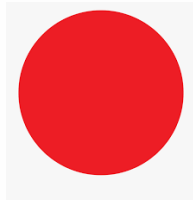
