
## Let's dophonics!




Hello friends! My name is Ruby.

Hello friends! My name is Ush.


Did you see the short "u" in my name followed by the two

Ush








Wonderful job, friends!

Are you ready to sound out the new words?


Here we go!


Let's read our sentence:

## He jumps over the big wall.








Let's read our sentence again:
