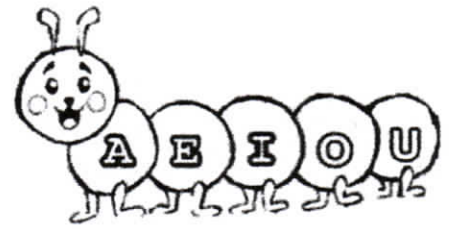

We saw a boat sink in the harbour.

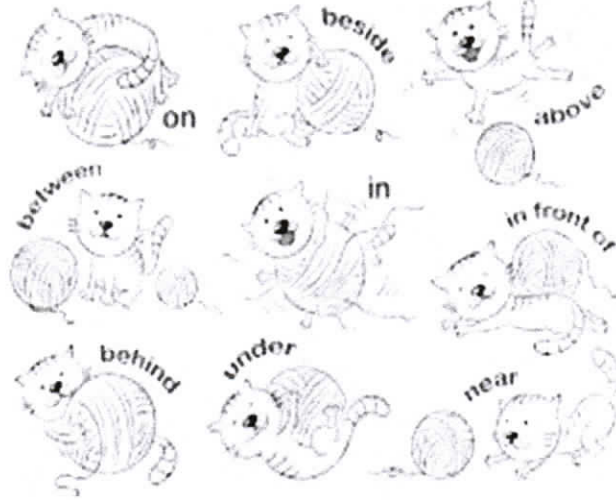
d. jump

What are prepositions?

They are words that describe the position of objects.
