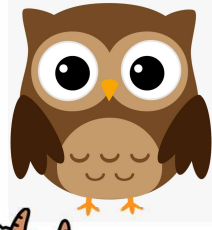


When two vowels go out walking, the **FIRST ONE**  
does the **TALKING**.

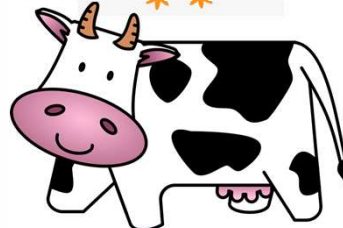
