Plural Nouns

When you are talking about two or more people, animals, places, or things, use plural nouns.



Most nouns are made plural by adding -s at the end.

Singular	Plural	Singular	Plural
rose	roses	pig	pigs
pencil	pencils	flower	flowers
tree	trees	building	buildings

When the last letters of singular nouns are

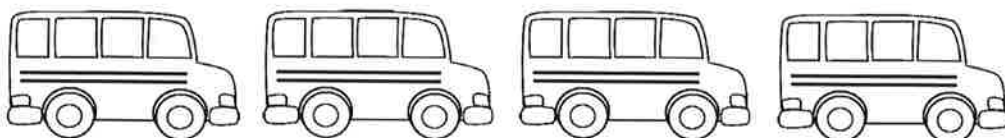
-ch; -sh; -s; -ss or -x

you usually add -es to form the plural.

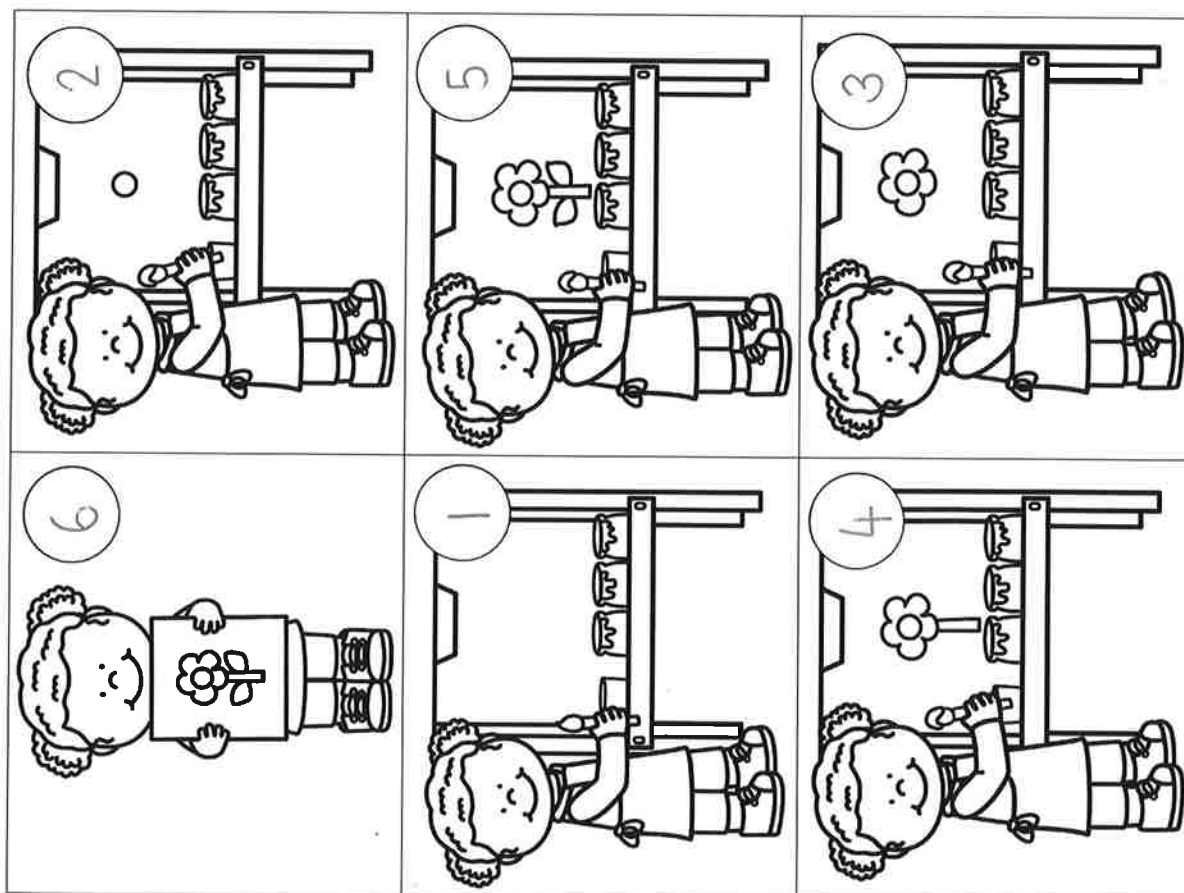


Some plural nouns end in -es.
