The **pretty** **girl** is wearing a **beautiful** **dress**.

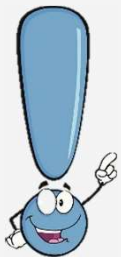


# FIND THE ADJECTIVES

Remember the adjectives tells us more about the noun so look for the noun first!



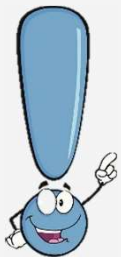


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Remember friends, the adjective will **always**
