Electric thunderstorms are exciting and scary. We see lightning. We hear thunder. Lightning is dangerous. It can give you an electric shock.





A rainbow has seven colours. They are red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo and violet. You can only see a rainbow when the sun is behind you. The sun shines through raindrops to make a rainbow.





Water



People need water to live. We use water for drinking, washing and growing plants. We use water in factories and hospitals.





Rain



Rain gives us water. Too much rain causes a flood. Too little rain causes a drought. We build dams to store water. Then we have water all year round.
