

Plural nouns

When a word shows more than one of something, we add **-s** to the end of the word.

Example: **prize – prizes**

But, some words do not work like this. For words that end with an **-s**, **-sh**, **-ch**, or **-z** we add **-es**.

Examples:

guess – guesses

stitch – stitches

wish – wishes

fox – foxes

Add **-s** or **-es** to these words to make them plural.
