Spelling and punctuation

- Add -es to form plurals of words ending in -s, -sh, -ch, or -z
- Words with long vowel sounds and silent -e

Working with words and sentences

- Revise 'a' and 'the' with nouns
- No article with uncountable nouns
- Simple present to describe universal statements
- Connecting words showing addition, sequence and contrast (but, then, and)
- Future tense (will, is/are going to)
