Long vowel sounds

Vowels are the letters **a, e, i, o** and **u**.

All the other letters in the alphabet are **consonants**.

The word **not** ends in a **consonant**. If you add an **-e** to the end of it, it makes the **vowel** sound **long**, for example: **note**. (You do not say the **e**.)
