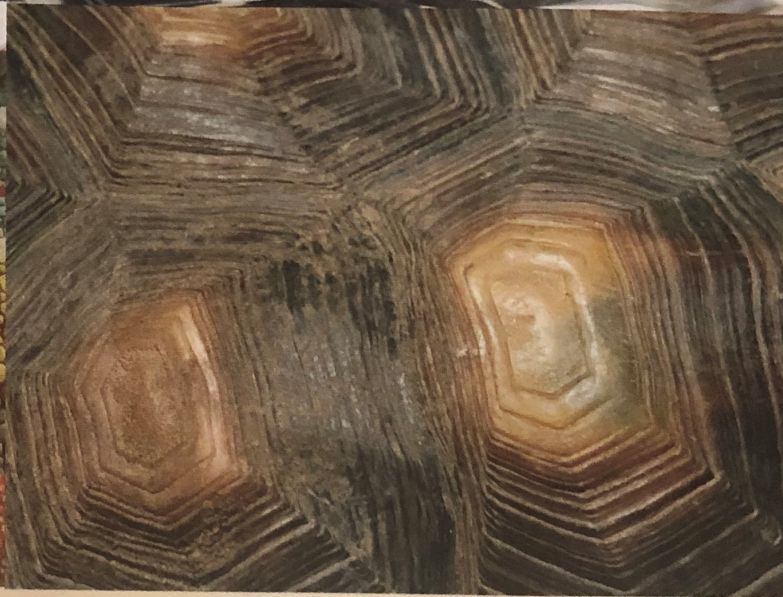
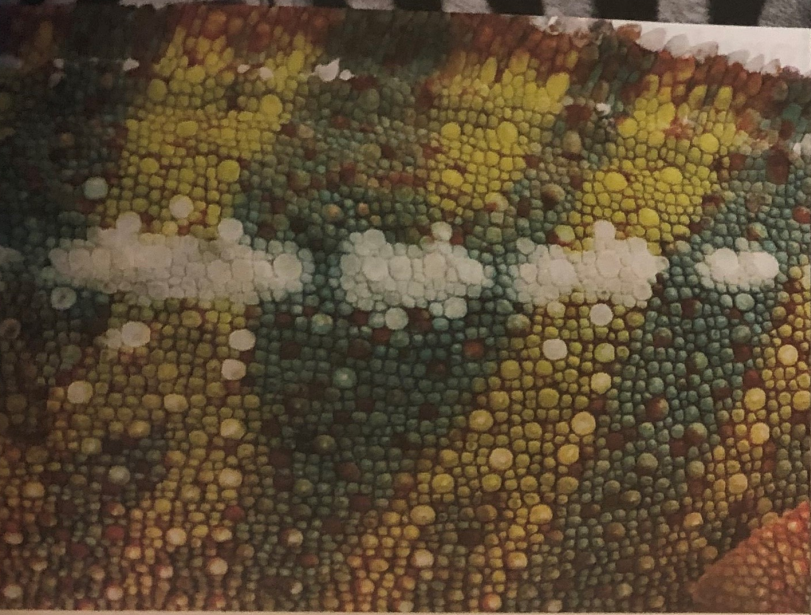
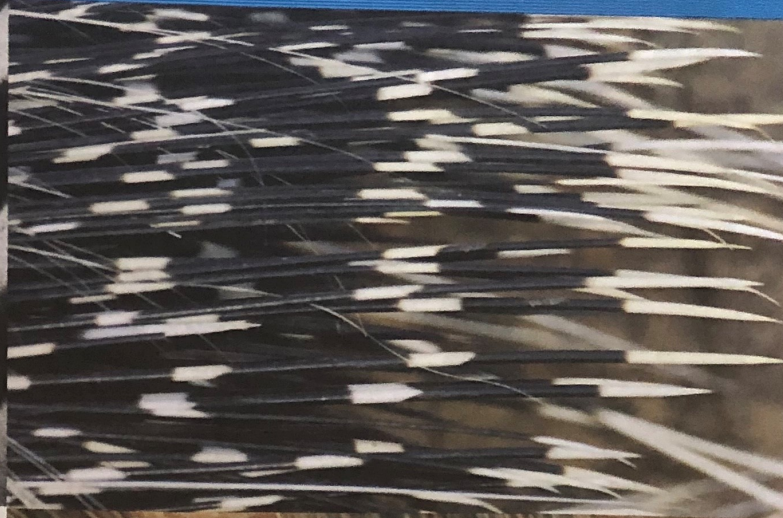


# Animal stories and poems



**In this two-week cycle you will learn and practise these skills:**

**Listen and speak** (1 hour per week)

- Listen to and discuss a traditional story
- Listen to and discuss a poem with rhyme and rhythm

Practise listening and speaking daily

**Read and view** (2.5 hours per week)

- Read and discuss a traditional story
  - Read and discuss a poem
- Practise reading aloud

Read independently

**Write and present** (1 hour per week)

- Write pairs of sentences with rhyme and rhythm
- Write a story using a frame

**Language structures and conventions**

(30 minutes formal practice per week)

**Spelling and punctuation**

- Words starting with c and followed by -e, -i or -y
- Words starting with k and followed by -e, -i

**Work with words and sentences**

- Countable nouns (a, the)
- Adjectives before nouns
- Forms of the verb 'to be'
- Adverbs of degree (too, very, more, almost)

**Vocabulary in context**

- Phrasal verbs (turn around)
