## Past Tense



We use the past tense to talk about things that happened in the past. In the past tense we <u>mostly add –ed</u> at the end of the verb: play – played.

There are also many <u>irregular verbs</u> that do not take -ed: eat – ate






## Questions and Negatives



You use **did** to form questions and negatives in past tense. You use did for singular and plural, which makes it easier.





## Irregular Verbs



Not all past tense verbs end in -ed, like played, jumped etc.
