Past Tense

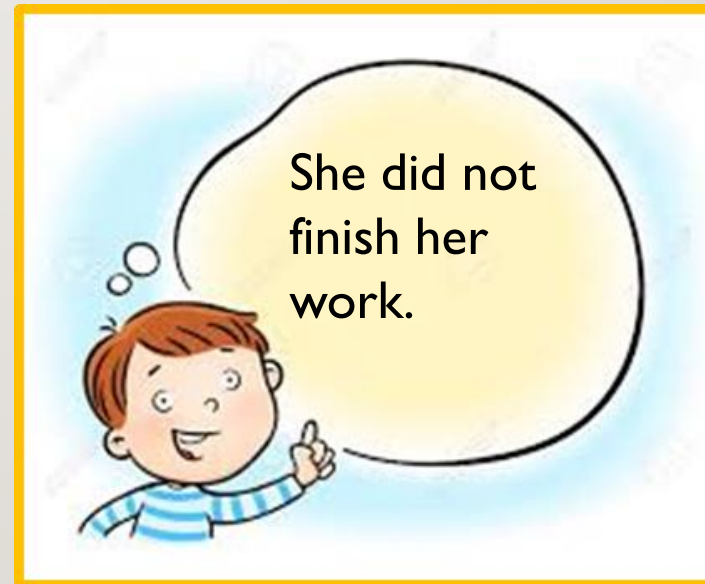
We use the past tense to talk about things that happened in the past. In the past tense we mostly add -ed at the end of the verb: play – played.

There are also many irregular verbs that do not take -ed: eat – ate



Questions and Negatives

You use **did** to form questions and negatives in past tense. You use **did** for singular and plural, which makes it easier.



Irregular Verbs

Not all past tense verbs end in –ed, like played, jumped etc.
