Please take note:

- Write proper headings with page references and dates.
- Attempt all the questions, do not leave blank spaces. All this work will have memorandums that will be sent to you the next week.
- All page references refer to your text book, Platinum.
- Continue speaking five minutes English **every day**. Get a specific time at which you do this, for example before or after doing your English, at dinner time, etc.
- Read English for 3 minutes before you start your English work **every day**, as you do in class. This must be from a book of your own choice. Then tell your mother/brother/sister/cat/dog what you have just read.

Monday 6 July	Own reading book <u>Gr 4</u> <u>PowerPoint</u> : The Summary Part 1 <u>Gr 4</u> <u>PowerPoint</u> : The Summary Part 2	Three minutes reading and then reporting. Before you start the work for week 12, check that you have completed and marked week 10. Revise work. We did not do the summary last year in Grade 4. You first need to see what the Grade four learners are doing, before you can progress to Grade 5's summary. View these two power points on the introduction to summarizing. You do not have to write anything down. Follow instructions on the power point.
Tuesday 7 July	Own reading book <u>Gr 5</u> <u>PowerPoint</u> : The Summary Part 1 <u>Worksheet</u> : Gr 5 Summary	Three minutes reading and then reporting. Follow instructions on the power point. Complete the summary of The Dove and the Ant in your classwork book.
Wednesday 8 July	Own reading book <u>PowerPoint</u> : The Summary Part 2 <u>Worksheet</u> : Gr 5 Summary	Three minutes reading and then reporting. Follow instructions on the power point. Complete the summary of Classroom Rules in your classwork book.
Thursday 9 July	Own reading book <u>PowerPoint</u> : Riddles	Three minutes reading and then reporting. See if you can find the answers to the riddles on the power point.
Friday 10 July	<u>Spelling</u> : Group 9 <u>PowerPoint</u> : Spelling Own reading book	Practise the words. Get someone to ask you 20 of these words. You may read aloud for at least 10 minutes.
