Summary

If your friend were absent the previous day and asked you what had happened at school. What would you reply? You have just 40 seconds to do so before the bell rings.

Choose one of the following options:

- a) I would mention all the details of the day, from the moment we entered the class until the end of the day.
- b) I would just mention the important things that he/she needs to know.
- c) I would quote what the teacher said exactly.

You should choose b), because you need to summarize the day and just mention the important things.

What is summarizing?

When you take a longer piece of writing or speech and make it much shorter by mentioning only the important points.

A good summary must:

- just mention the main/most important details
- not have many examples
- be written in a clear, short sentence
- not be copied word for word

Choose the answer that best summarizes the following paragraph.

I was so scared when I first learned that I would be having my tooth pulled. I did not sleep at all the night before. I was terrified that it would hurt more than I could stand. I was shaking when I sat in the dentist's chair. She promised me that it would not hurt, but I certainly had my doubts. The dentist gave me some medicine. When I awoke, my tooth was gone, and I did not remember a thing.

- a) The writer had toothache. She was scared and could not sleep all night.
- b) The dentist gave me some medicine. When I awoke, my tooth was gone.
- c) The dentist gave the writer medicine, to help when her tooth was pulled.

Summaries can be based on fiction (stories) or non-fiction (facts) passages.

When summarizing stories, you can use "the hand method".

Write the 5 W's (who, when, where, what, why on each finger and how in the palm)

- 1. Write who was in the story in five words.
- 2. Write what happened in ten to fifteen words.
- 3. Write when it happened in five words.
- 4. Write where it happened in five words.
- 5. Write why it happened in five words.
- 6. Write how it happened in five words.

Then you can write the steps in full sentences, taking note of the word limit.

If you have more words than the limit, then you need to leave out some unnecessary details.

Summarise the story below, by using the hand method. Just write the 6 steps.
