Please take note:

- Write proper headings with page references and dates.
- Attempt all the questions, do not leave blank spaces. All this work will have memorandums that will be sent to you the next week.

- Continue speaking five minutes English **every day**. Get a specific time at which you do this, for example before or after doing your English, at dinner time, etc.
- Read English for 3 minutes before you start your English work **every day**, as you do in class. This must be from a book of your own choice. Then tell your mother/brother/sister/cat/dog what you have just read.

Monday 13 July	Own reading book Platinum:pp.98,99 <u>Power point:</u> Examination paper	Three minutes reading and then reporting. Before you start the work for week 13, check that you have completed and marked week 12. Revise work. You are not writing an examination paper this term, therefore it will be good to do the paper in the text book, as practice. First do the reading comprehension test. Follow instructions on the power point.
Tuesday 14 July	Own reading book Platinum p.99 <u>Power point:</u> Examination paper	Three minutes reading and then reporting. Do the language in context questions in your classwork book. <u>Take note:</u> in some of the older text books the questions are numbered incorrectly. After no 6 just number the rest 7, 8 and 9.
Wednesday 15 July	Own reading book <u>Memo:</u> Examination paper 2	Three minutes reading and then reporting. Mark the comprehension test and the language in context questions.
Thursday 16 July	Own reading book <u>Worksheet:</u> Phrases	Three minutes reading and then reporting. Write Phrases as your heading and just write the correct phrase in your classwork book. Find the answers in Memo week 13 file.
Friday 17 July	<u>Spelling:</u> Group 10 <u>PowerPoint:</u> Spelling Own reading book	Practise the words. Get someone to ask you 20 of these words. You may read aloud for at least 10 minutes.
