There are stars <u>everywhere</u> in space.

There is gas <u>inside</u> the planet.

## Adverb of degree (how much?)

The study of planets is <u>extremely</u> fascinating.

The other planets are quite far from earth.

# Revision Complex sentences p.66 no 1 Memorandum

- 1a) I'm going to keep practicing, so that I **become** good at it.
- b) David learnt how to juggle, while he **was singing** a song. / while he **was** in Grade 5.
- c) I collected the balls, which **were lying** on the ground.

#### Take note:

Do not just write singing or lying on its own – it is not a finite (full) verb.

You do not say. "She singing a song." You need to say, "She was singing a song."

- 2a) A + B Good ball skills will definitely improve your chances of being successful. You also need to be determined or else you will give up too soon, as juggling is not easy.
