Thursday 7 May	Own reading book Platinum p.71 Power Point: Week 3	Three minutes reading and then reporting. Adjectives. Follow instructions on PowerPoint Week 3. Look up better adjectives in a thesaurus or Google and write a sentence to describe each animal.

Friday 8 May	Own reading book Spelling group 3	Three minutes reading and then reporting. Practise group 3 and write a spelling test. Read aloud for at least 10 minutes.
