Mark the exercises done in week 4 – see file: Week 4 Memos. Make sure all work for week 4 has been completed and marked. Revise work. Look at the photographs and discuss no 1-3, follow instructions in the power point.
Tuesday 19 May	Own reading book Platinum p.78 YouTube video: Benjamin Zephaniah Talking Turkeys(3:10) Platinum p.197 PowerPoint: Detailed instructions Week 5	Three minutes reading and then reporting. Look at the picture in the text book. Discuss the “Before you listen” questions. Then watch the YouTube video where the Jamaican poet Benjamin Zephaniah, recites the poem. Follow the poem on p.197 Do no 2 in your classwork book. Discuss no 3. Follow detailed instructions on power point.
Wednesday 20 May	Own reading book Platinum p.79 PowerPoint: Detailed instructions Week 5	Three minutes reading and then reporting. Read the notes on alliteration, assonance and consonance in the text book. Do no 1-4 in your classwork book. Follow detailed instructions on power point.
Thursday 21 May	Own reading book Platinum pp.80,81 PowerPoint: Week 5 Roald Dahl Revoltin' Rhymes (pdf)	Three minutes reading and then reporting. Read Roald Dahl's poem, Little Red Riding Hood. Do no 1-3 on p.81 Read other examples of Roald Dahl's poems in the attached pdf file. These poems are normally used for a role-play oral, which is a lot of fun. Unfortunately we cannot do it in this term.
Friday 22 May	<u>Spelling</u> Group 5 Own reading book	Practise the words and write a spelling test adding up to 20. Read aloud for at least 10 minutes.
