

Subject and Predicate p.76

A sentence can be divided into a subject and predicate.

Subject: the person or object that does the action.

Predicate: the rest of the sentence

The Grade 6 learners are trying to finish their projects.

Finding the subject

- 1. Find the verb in the sentence
- 2. Ask who/what + verb
- Every morning the eager girl skips to school.
- Verb = skips
- Who/what skips?
- The eager girl = subject
- Predicate = every morning skips to school



The (direct) object
the person/thing that receives the action

- To find the object:
- 1. find the verb
- 2. ask verb + who/what = object
- The tennis player hits the ball.
- Verb = hits
- Hits who/what?
- the ball = object
