- 3. Fit the new bulb. Do not over-tighten or press on the bulb too hard.

- 5. Make sure you turn the switch off
- 6. Let the bulb cool down for about 30 seconds or more. If there is no bulb, it is ok to skip this step.

- 8. Remove the burnt out lamp and throw it away properly. If you don't have a burnt out bulb to throw away, it is ok to go on to the next step.

Whitney Elizabeth Houston is an American recording artist, actress, producer, and model. The Guinness World Records cites her as the most-awarded female act of all-time. Houston is also one of the world's best-selling music artists, having sold over 170 million albums, singles and videos worldwide. She will release seven studio albums and three movie soundtrack albums. Houston's appeal on the popular music charts influences several African-American female artists to follow in her footsteps.

Houston's first acting role is in the feature film The Bodyguard (1992). Its lead single I Will Always Love You, is the best-selling single by a female artist in music history. Houston died on February 11, 2012. News of her death, the day before the 2012 Grammy Awards, dominates American and international media.
