

Answers

1. Sankhambi started the trouble.
2. He pulled the monkeys' tails.
3. The monkeys threw seeds and sticks at him.
4. Learners decide whether the monkeys were right or not – they must explain why they think so.
5. Learners refer to the 'Word list' to check the meaning of the saying and answer accurately.
6. The correct order is:
 - Sankhambi tells the monkeys about a cave with honeycomb in it.
 - The monkeys follow Sankhambi to the cave.
 - Sankhambi pretends that the roof of the cave is falling down.
 - The monkeys hold the roof up while Sankhambi pretends to look for poles.
 - The monkeys stand there for a day and a night before they realise they have been tricked.
7. Example of completed sentences are:
 - a) The monkeys have flat tummies because they stood with their arms stretched up above their heads and worked hard to hold the roof of the cave up.
 - b) I think the monkeys are stupid because they thought that they could hold up a cave roof.
