Please take note:

Make sure all work for week 7 has been completed and marked. Revise work. Read about weather instruments on the power point.
Tuesday 9 June	Own reading book Platinum p.106 PowerPoint: Detailed instructions Week 8	Three minutes reading and then reporting. Read the passage Predicting the weather in the text book and do no 1-4 in your classwork book. Read the winter riddles on the power point.
Wednesday 10 June	Own reading book Platinum pp.108,109 PowerPoint: Detailed instructions Week 8	Three minutes reading and then reporting. Read the passage, wordlist and graph in the text book and do no 1-4 in your classwork book. Identify the cities
Thursday 11 June	Own reading book Platinum p.111 PowerPoint: Detailed instructions Week 8	Three minutes reading and then reporting. Read the notes about Simple past tense and do no 1a)-c) in your classwork book. Read the notes about adjectives in the text book and do no 2a)-d) in your classwork book. Predict the weather for tomorrow and see if you can make an accurate prediction. Write it down in your classwork book.
Friday 12 June	<u>Spelling</u> Group 12 PowerPoint: Detailed instructions Own reading book	Follow instructions on power point. Practise the words and write the three sentences for your spelling test. You can do the spelling word search if you want to. Read aloud for at least 10 minutes.
