

Unit 5 The colon and the semi-colon

The colon (:) and the semi-colon (;) look very similar, but they do totally different jobs.

The colon (:)

- The colon can show that a list will follow the main clause.

Example:

Matthew went to the pharmacy to buy the following: cough mixture, vitamins and face wash.

- It is also used to show that an explanation will follow.

Example:

Walter looked into the mirror: he wanted to see how dirty he had become after the muddy soccer match.

- A colon introduces a quotation or a definition.

Example:

Remember this proverb: 'Beauty is in the eye of the beholder.'

The semi-colon (;)

- The semi-colon joins two clauses, replacing *but* or *and*.

Example:

The boy looked into the mirror; he was happy with his reflection.

- You can use a semi-colon when too many commas are found in a list.

Example:

You get pimples, which are big inflamed spots; whiteheads with white pus; blackheads, which are those black, oily spots; and blind pimples.
